Description

Conversation Starters are a series of informal learning and teaching lunch time conversation sessions designed to connect teachers from different disciplines and faculties at UOW (Wollongong Campus). The aim is to create a supportive community where teachers can come together in person to share experiences, develop cross- disciplinary relationships, and learn tips and tricks for improving learning, teaching, connection, and wellbeing.

This conversation will shine a spotlight on the CABLE program (AAUT Citation 2021), a faculty-based, voluntary student association that has been dedicated to offering peer-assisted academic support, mentoring, and fostering social engagement among UOW students since its establishment in 2010.
