

ACCESS AND USE OF UOW'S WIRELESS NETWORK

The access and use of UOW's wireless network system and access to the network, including all related equipment, networks, network devices (including internet access) and electronic resources at UOW is restricted to staff, students, and individuals authorised by UOW.

All users are required to comply with UOW's IT Acceptable Use Policy and other relevant UOW policies and legislation when accessing and using UOW's wireless network.

When users access or log in to UOW's WI-FI network, UOW will collect certain information, including (but not limited to) account usernames, IP addresses, MAC addresses and network activity.

UOW may use or hold this information for the following activities:

- to ensure that the use is authorised;
- for the management of the network and related University systems and services;
- to investigate the use of the network for breach of any laws or University policies;
- to assist in obtaining analytical data relating to the use of the network e.g. future planning for space/infrastructure management.

Anonymised data will be used by UOW for reporting purposes, and where practicable, when carrying out any of the above activities.
